

ASTROLOGY: Planetary Event Calendar for November, 2022 by Joe DiSabatino

The first two weeks of November look to be particularly challenging for the world as the Sun, Mercury and Venus in Scorpio (search for truth that's been hidden) make strong aspects to the dark energy of the Saturn in Aquarius/Uranus in Taurus square that is peaking in intensity. Sun/Mercury/Venus will oppose Uranus: sudden and expected turn of events, rebellion, challenges to authority, new discoveries about documents and written communications come to light. Sun/Mercury/Venus will square Saturn: those in power resist the changes Uranus is calling for, using whatever means they have to enforce their will. So expect immense power struggles and clash of values.

At the same time Mars in Gemini is retrograde (Oct. 30-Jan.12), clashing with Neptune in Pisces the whole month of November: confusion, deception, misinformation, particularly in Gemini-related activities, such as voting and the communication of voting results, anything to do with documents, and the spread of information/misinformation in general. Major new actions made during a Mars Retrograde period often don't work out as intended.

Adding to the power and critical importance of these alignments, on November 8th (mid-term election day) there's a total Lunar Eclipse at the Full Moon which means that Sun/Moon/Mercury/Venus and Saturn/Uranus are all strongly aligned to the Lunar Nodes. This is a Moon Wobble period which creates instability. What I see in this is a crisis of major proportions for the world and for the USA's election process that will have long-lasting ramifications. This election looks to be extremely controversial.

The New Moon on Oct. 25th was also a partial Solar Eclipse. So we're in an eclipse period; eclipses are triggers for crises and major turning points. The Solar and Lunar eclipses on Oct.25 and Nov. 8th happen in Scorpio and Taurus, a crises-prone axis anyway.

On a positive note, Sun/Mercury/Venus in Scorpio move on from clashing with Saturn and Uranus to then make positive links to Neptune and Jupiter in late Pisces (meaning truth, justice, ethical practices) from November 13th-23rd. Jupiter and Neptune coming together in 2022 in Pisces is an astrological signature that there are forces of good having a strong influence in the world, despite opposite forces having their day, as indicated by the ongoing Saturn square Uranus dark energy.

The influence of the ongoing Saturn/Uranus square doesn't end until first week of March. The atrocities in the Ukraine war, the uncertainties in the global and domestic economy, clashes between forces of change and forces of repression, violent/angry outbursts by individuals, and also many people feeling high levels of anxiety without knowing why are some of the manifestations of the Saturn/Uranus clash.

Key Dates in November:

- 1. Nov. 1-12th: the Sun, Mercury and Venus in Scorpio conjunct the Lunar South Node in Scorpio and oppose the Lunar North Node and Uranus in Taurus, and all these square Saturn in Aquarius, creating a tense T-square right at the Total Lunar Eclipse on November 8th.** It's a dangerous time for the world. On a personal level, it's best to wait until the Sun enters Sagittarius on Nov 21st before embarking on a major life change, such as purchasing a home, moving, starting a new business, etc.
- 2. Nov 8: Full Moon and Total Lunar Eclipse takes place at 6:03 am in Myrtle Beach.** It will be visible just before sunrise.
- 3. Nov. 13-23: The Sun, Mercury and Venus in Scorpio move past the clash angles with Saturn and Uranus and then on these days make positive aspects with Neptune and Jupiter, both in Pisces.** As I stated above, this is a positive influence for the world. On a personal level, these are good days for travel, pre-Thanksgiving planning, renewing/enjoying emotional bonds with family and friends (Water signs=emotional bonds).
- 4. Nov. 23rd: Jupiter turns direct on same day as the New Moon (5:58 pm in Myrtle Beach) at 1 degree of Sagittarius.** There's a lot of positive Jupiter energy at this New Moon: Jupiter rules Sagittarius, Jupiter turns direct right at the New Moon, and the Sun and Moon conjunct in early Sagittarius make a flowing connection with Jupiter itself in late Pisces. This New Moon is asking us to renew our faith in ourselves, in humanity, in the future despite discouraging world events and trends. Good month for visualizing life goals and writing them down (Venus and Mercury are also conjunct in Sagittarius at the New Moon).
- 5. Nov. 27-30th: Venus and Mercury in Sagittarius oppose retrograde Mars in Gemini and all three planets square Neptune in Pisces, creating another tense T-square.** There's a battle going on between accurate information and mis-information with Neptune making it difficult to know which is which. These are also not the best days for launching major new projects as T-squares will put a monkey wrench in the works.
