COVID UPDATE

I've been saying since the outbreak of Covid 19, that the virus will remain strongly active until the end of 2021. Starting in the new year, the infection/death rate should begin to slowly fade out through the Spring, 2022. The astrology of the pandemic is based on the work of Richard Tarnas in his amazing book, *Cosmos and Psyche: Intimations of A New World View* (2007). The Saturn/Pluto conjunction, which occurs every 38 years, is the culprit. Tarnas researched the various social and cultural effects of that periodic outer planet alignment going back centuries. And one repeating manifestation he found is a pandemic. (The rise of ultra-conservative political forces is another.) The dark effects of the Saturn/Pluto conjunction lasts about three years which is the time it takes for Saturn to approach within 15 degrees of Pluto, from the exact conjunction (took place January 10th, 2020), and then move 15 degrees past Pluto (which occurs mid-December, 2021.) Maybe in the future, governments will acknowledge Tarnas' work, prepare for the next pandemic, and not prematurely assume it is over during a lull. The next Saturn/Pluto conjunction occurs 2055-2058.

MOON WOBBLE UPDATE

Also, as I wrote in August report, there was a Moon Wobble period extending from the last week of August through the first week of September, peaking August 27-30th. Often the most traumatic natural and man-made disasters happen during the two-week Moon Wobble period (Solar and Lunar eclipses, and the Sun at a 90 degree angle to the Lunar Nodes make for a Moon Wobble.) One of these will occur approximately every 83 days. This time it was hurricane Ida (hurricane Katrina was also a Moon Wobble event) and other dramatic world events in the final week of August and first week of September.

September looks to be one of the smoothest months of the year. We all deserve a break!

Key Days in September:

1. **September 1-7. As explained above, the Moon Wobble's destabilizing energy is still present the first week of the month, though its energy gradually wanes.** Despite the Wobble, the Sun makes a favorable aspect to Uranus, and Venus and Mars make strong aspects to Pluto and Jupiter during this week. So anything to do with technology, innovative projects, love and money are favored.
2. **Sept. 6th. The New Moon in Virgo occurs at 8:52 pm in Beach.** Good time to meditate on where in your life you can be of service, be more organized, especially with work routines, and generally be more practical. Good time to connect to the earth through gardening or walks in nature.
3. **Sept. 14-18. The Sun in Virgo makes a positive connection to Pluto in Capricorn while Venus in Scorpio makes a stressful aspect to Saturn in Aquarius.** Career moves are favored, though be cautious with financial investments and major purchases these days. Venus/Saturn signifies buyer's regret. Also not good days to start a new relationship.

4. **Sept. 20-24: Mercury makes strong aspects to Jupiter and Pluto while Venus in Scorpio opposes Uranus in Taurus.** Good days for travel, written communications, or getting your art out into the world. Venus/Uranus aspects bring art or entertainment into your life that is new and exciting. They also mean relationship issues related to intimacy vs independence get stirred up.
5. **Sept. 27-30. Venus makes strong links to Jupiter and Neptune while Mars does the same with Saturn.** Good days for love, romance and making relationship commitments such as getting engaged.
6. **Sept. 23-27. Sun in Libra makes a positive connection to the Nodes.** This aspect is the opposite of the Moon Wobble. It brings stability and success.
7. **Sept. 27th. Mercury in Libra turns retrograde until October 18th.**

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
